

NOTICE OF RACE EUROSAIL 2025

Sailing Event European National Banks at 13 and 14 June 2025.

Location: Slotermeer (Provence Fryslân – The Netherlands)

Organizing Authority: WSV Sleattemermar assisted by the WSV DNB

1 RULES

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in <u>Racing Rules of Sailing</u> (RRS) 2025 2028.
- 1.2 The rules below do not change any of the RRS. The sailing instructions may change the RRS.
- **1.3** If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 2.1 The sailing instructions will be available after June 1st 2025, on the website at http://www.sleattemermar.nl and will be shared through e-mail to the participating teams. Other documents governing the event will be published with the Sailing Instructions.
- 2.2 Any change to the sailing instructions will be posted on the notice board and via WhatsApp before 09:00 hrs on the day it will take effect.
- 2.3 A change to the schedule of races will be posted on the notice board and via WhatsApp by 20:00 hrs on the day before it will take effect.

3 COMMUNICATIONS

- 3.1 The official Notice Board is located at palaver venue which is located at the accommodation terrain (Lutz Villas / Captain Cave) and at the Regatta Office in the clubhouse of the Sailing club Sleattemermar.
- 3.2 The event may use WhatsApp groups for communication purposes with competitors.
- 3.3 While racing, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.
- 3.4 On June 13th a palaver will be held at 08.15 hrs. and on June 14th a palaver will be held at 08.15 hrs.

4 SCHEDULE

4.1 Date and number of races:

	Date	Races per day	Warningsignal race 1

Saturday	14-06	4-8	09:55 hrs.

- 4.2 When weather circumstances are suitable the RC has the intention to show code flag "E" on the finishing vessel after the finish of the first 2-3 races on Friday June 13th and after the finish of the first 2-4 races on Saturday June 14th .
 Showing code flag "E" means that there will be a pause for a lunch ashore. The time
 - of the warning signal for the next race after the pause will be posted on the Notice
 Board and flag AP will be displayed ashore in front of the Regatta Office.
- 4.3 No warning signal shall be made later than 14:45 hrs. on Friday June 13th.

 On Saturday June 14th, the last day of EUROSAIL 2025, no warning signal will be made later than 15:45 hours.

5 VENUE

- 5.1 The palaver venue is located at the accommodation terrain (Lutz Villas / Captain Cave).
- 5.2 NOR Addendum A shows the location of the regatta harbour.
- 5.2 NOR Addendum B shows the location of the racing area.

6 COURSES

- 6.1 The course to be sailed will be Windward/Leeward.
- 6.2 The course and marks that will be used are described in the SI.

7 SCORING

- 7.1 (a) When fewer than 5 races have been complied, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
 - (b) When 5 to 9 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
 - (c) When 10 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding the two worsts scores.

8 COMMITTEE VESSELS AND SUPPORT PERSON VESSELS

- 8.1 Committee vessels shall be marked with an orange flag with RC (Race Committee).
- 8.2 Support person boats shall be marked with a flag of their own country

9 CHARTERED BOATS

- 9.1 The regatta will be sailed in chartered boats of the type "Polyvalk". Boats will be recognizable by a bow number, delivered by the OA.
- 9.2 After the first day of sailing teams will change boats according to the results of that first day, i.e. the second day of racing a team that finished last in the scoring after one day racing sails the next day in the boat that finished first after one day racing etc. etc.

9.3 The new distribution of boats for the second day of racing will be posted on WhatsApp before 08.00 hours on the day it will take effect.

10 DATA PROTECTION

10.1 By participating in the EUROSAIL 2025 competitors automatically grant to the Organizing Authority and their sponsors, the right in perpetuity to make use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any (motion) pictures and live, taped, or filmed video and other reproductions of the athlete during the period of the competition without compensation.

11 RISK STATEMENT

- 11.1 RRS 3 states: "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone." By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk or injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia, or other causes.
- 11.2 The Organizing Authority will accept no liability for material damage or personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

12 INSURANCE

12.1 The boats are insured with a deductible of EUR 500. Each participating crew is liable for any damage caused by them limited to this amount.


13 PRIZES
